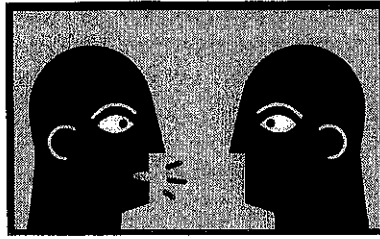

 - Assign the roles for the next week and organize role sheets.

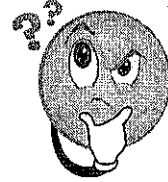
